


Historic native Tuscan grape varieties that went extinct

The phylloxera epidemic, originating from the Americas and hitting Europe in the mid-1800s, destroyed a third of Europe's vineyards, making numerous varieties extinct.

The native Renaissance grape varieties are being recovered through a research project at the University of Florence, which began with the discovery of some grape seeds in the Medici tombs after World War II and continued in the early 1980s with DNA experiments in the Vitiarium of Cortona.






The "Accoli"
